 know ye that I Elizabeth Walther of Jackson County Georgia being
 now in a low State of health & knowing the uncertainty of Life
 the uncertainty of Life I have thought proper to make my will
 & Dispose of my Property, which it hath been my duty to
 send you with which I give Donor & Dispose of in the manner
 & form following viz

Item 1st I give & bequeath to my good neighbor & friend Hadam?
 David all my Land Plantation & house & all its appurtenances
 = as to be & remain in full & true Possession of the same
 Immediately after my Death & I also give & bequeath
 to him my best & all my Pot Ware viz. Pots, Ovens, Skillets
 Spider & Every thing & things that come under the name
 of Pot Ware & also all my Earthenware Jars to him & his
 heirs & assigns forever

Item 2nd I give & bequeath to my Son Matthew my Brother
 Bed on which I now lie a short Counterpane & Bed quilt
 at my Death to be in the care of Hadam? David and
 Matthew may come or send for it to him & his heirs and
 assigns forever

Item 3rd all the Rest of my bed Cloathing of Every kind & Description
 whatever I give & bequeath to William George Children
 to them & their heirs & assigns forever & I further give and
 bequeath to the said William George Children & Polystrate
 Children all my wearing apparel & Cloathing of Every kind
 & Description to them & their heirs & assigns forever

Item 4th I give & bequeath to my Son Augustus William
 spinning wheel & my Wheel Reel to him & his heirs forever
 I further give & bequeath to William George Children
 all my sitting Chair & Table to them & their heirs forever
 & also two Little Bowls & Cups & Saucers

Item 5th I give & bequeath to Polly Ann Smith all my Earthen
 Plates & two Bowls to her & her heirs forever
 I further give & bequeath to Hadam? David my diploma
 and all the Rest of Property not heretofore bequeathed to nothing
 Except one Pewter Basin & three Wash Tubs which I
 give & bequeath to Polly Ann Smith & all the Rest

I Repeal of My Property Not otherwise Willed I do & bequeath
to the said Haden J. David & I desire him to take Charge of my
Estate Immediately after My Death & be in full Possession of the
Premises & Every Thing & Things untill Every Thing I have Willed
May be gotten away

I do hereby Mournate & appoint him the said
Haden J. David the Whole & Sole Executor to this My Last
Will & Testament
