 & Disposse of my Property which it hath been my lot to  
 Inherit from which I give away & Disposse of in the manner  
 & form following 203

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give & bequeath to my good neighbour & friend Hadley  
 David all my Land Plantation & house & all its appurten-  
 = ces to be & remain in full & true Possession of the same  
 Immediately after my Death & I also give & bequeath  
 to him my Chayl & all my Bed Ware Wiz. Bed, Burg Shutter  
 Spid & every thing & thingz that concerneth the man-  
 of Bed Ware & also all my Earthware Jars to him & his  
 heirs & assigns forever

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my Son Nathan my Brother  
 But on which I now die a short Counterpane & Bedgut  
 at my Death to be in the care of Hadley & David and  
 Nathan may come or send for it to him & his heirs and  
 assigns forever

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> all the Rest of my bed Cloathing of every kind & Description  
 whatever I have & bequeath to William Voryong Children  
 to them & their heirs & assigns forever & I further give and  
 bequeath to the said William Voryong Children & Polly Crumby  
 Children all my Wearing apparel & Cloathing of every kind  
 & Description to them & their heirs & assigns for ever

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath to my son George Walker  
 Spring Wheel & My Chest Nut to him & his heirs forever  
 I further give & bequeath to William Voryong Children  
 all my Setting Chairz & Table to them & their heirs forever  
 & also two Little Bowly & Cup & Saucer

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath to Polly Ann Smith all my Earthen  
 Plates & two Bowly to her & her heirs forever  
 I further give & bequeath to Hadley J. Davis my uppon  
 and all the Rest of Property not heretofore Alotted to others  
 Except one Pewter Boyer & Three Wash Tubz White
