 as the Crop what I have Made More Wendie I weigh Branght
 home & Put within the Ballroom of my Portion at home & all other
 together also my goods of things I have my ability & Every thing
 Pertaining to my Distilling all of the Ballroom of my stock
 of hogs &c. what I shall hereafter acquire together with
 all the Revenue of my purchasable property I weigh sold & Hand
 to the Payment of my Debts

I Give & bequeath to the family to my Mother & the Ballroom the
 living with her hogs enough to make them live for the next
 year to be Judged of by my Executor the Ballroom of my hogs
 to be sold & appropriated as stated in the first Item

My Land I Give & bequeath Equally between my three Brothers
 namely Berry Thomas & Jas. Wendie

after all is sold that I have Devoted & Plead to my Debt
 as Devoted if there is not a Sufficient to pay my Debt I
 weigh my Land sold & Plead to the Debt if there should
 be any thing over upon the Sale of the Property Devoted
 in the first Item I Give & bequeath it to my Mother Sarah
 Wendie

if my Land has to be sold I Give Executor discretionary
 Power to sell the same to the best advantage
 I Constable with I appoint my Brother Berry Wendie to execute
 this my last will & Testament testifying
