Item I I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Rebecca Craft During her Natural Life
My part of the Land whereon I now live & my half also my Indivisible
Matters Down together with the plantation the farming utensils & household
& other furniture all my stock of hogs cattle & horses including all
personal property & also my negro Mary Peter & Randle my daughter in the
above it being half it is my wish & desire that after Rebecca Crafts
Death that said Peter & Randle have the privilege of keeping them
Major & after being sold the proceeds to be split for the support of sister
Martha of above & of 1850 to be equally divided between sister Emma
Craft daughter Hannah & sister Peggy Mary

Item 3 It is my will that my just debts be promptly paid
Item 4 It is my will & desire that all my aforesaid Estate should belong to
My said sister During her Natural Life as stated above & then to be
disposed of as stated above

Item 5 It is my will & desire that my debts be paid out of my aforesaid property
& the remainder to be disposed of as above directed

Item 6 It is my will that my sister Rebecca Craft be my Executor to this my will
I given under my hand & seal this 5 Day of September 1855
