

State of Oregon In the name of God amen. I, Mary Howard of Jackson County & said County & State being of Sound Mind & of legal Memory & Understanding that all Men are Free & Men in View of Death Make & publish this my last Will & Testament in Manner as follows To-wit:

First I give to my eldest Son, George John & Harper Howard the one fourth part of my Estate after Deducting & paying due charges after my decease for my dear Harry Howard & my Daughters Elizabeth & Amanda provided he pay to Charles Willitt to John J. Mcintosh each a balance & amount due them by him & for which I am indebted but if I have paid them to pay them he shall account to my Estate for such sums as are due & amount.

And I give to my three grand Sons George John & Harper Howard the one fourth part of my Estate (Deducting as aforesaid) provided they account for the sum of Six hundred Dollars & being an advance I have made to their father Harper H. Howard

Fourth I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Willitt one fourth part of my Estate (Deducting as aforesaid) provided she account for a sum of four hundred Dollars advanced to her by her husband, & Willitt the sum of four hundred Dollars the income of the same to be for her & her heirs & her eldest Son during her natural life & then the same to be divided between her two children her Daughter & C. Willitt accounting for said sum at the price of four hundred Dollars at the time of said Daughter's decease

Fifth I give to my Son Washford Howard one fourth part of my Estate (Deducting as aforesaid) when he shall account for an advancement of eleven hundred Dollars made to him

Sixth I give to my Son Harry Howard Eighty Dollars & the one fourth part of my Estate when he shall account for the sum of Eight hundred Dollars which I have advanced to him

Seventh I give to my Daughter Emily Willitt Eighty Dollars with one fourth part of my Estate when she shall account for the sum of Seven hundred & ten Dollars advanced to her at the price of twelve hundred Dollars

Eighth I give to my Daughter Amanda Parker Eighty Dollars & one fourth part of

Fourth I give to my Daughter Malissa Beazell the one month part of my Estate  
(Deduction as aforesaid) when she shall account for one to go give &  
advised to her at the price of four Hundred Dollars

Fifth I give to my son Horner Be Howard one month part of my Estate (Deduction  
as aforesaid) and desire that if it be his wish he shall take my my land  
the plantation between I want close at the same or price of one thousand  
three Hundred Dollars And I further will & desire that if any of the legates  
under this my will shall to do as in law & thereby shall to  
Defeat my Intentions as herein expressed he or she shall forever  
forfeit all & every Intest, which shall Legates may appear to have  
in this my will

Sixthly I hereby complete & approve my Test above writing Hugh McQuinn  
and Green McQuinn of this my last will & Testament hereby  
Declaring all other wills heretofore made by me utterly void & of no  
Effect to be my last will
