 after her death shall be subject to the same division as
 the other place I live on would have been and if my daughter
 Elisabeth Caroline Potts out live, her mother she shall
 have the control and management of the land in peaceable
 possession during her natural life or any land
 purchased with the effects there of & if my wife Wmty
 Potts dies said premises her title shall be good & valid
 to the purchaser as if made by me in my life time
 and if my daughter Elisabeth Caroline Potts should
 marry she shall have no power in her self or her hus-
 band to sell any part of my Estate so as to put it out
 of the reach of the balance of my Children

 named Children the portion of either of them who may
 die with out Children ^{shall belong to the others after their death} ^{Considerable} my sons Moses
