County & State aforesaid during of Seven & Dispensing Third & Money of the sum of
the sume amount of Sixty Two Thousand Hunders and my last Will & Testament here by done
being all former Wills
Item 4th it is my will that my funeral expenses be first paid in satisfying th
same at the Disposition of my Executor

Item 5th it is my will that all my Negroes be divided amongst my children to
John H. Marshall A Frank H. Kelly Thornton Melinda Butler Green
Borden & Aaron Wellerby that they be appraised by disinterested persons
as soon as so much as practicable & drawn for

Item 5th all the remainder of my property both real & personal I desire shall
be sold at publick sale over credit of twelve months with bids & appraisals
several of the land to be sold in such lots as my Executor shall determine
most convenient to the interest of my estate

Item 5th I give my Executors herein after named my Daugt for my three young
children of my Daughter Melinda Howard who is Deaf & Dumb
& blind each Three Hundred Dollars to be Disbursed in the hands of said
Executor until they become of age in the event that any of the children
should die a minor the succession or succession to inherit the whole of it
Item 5th following the foregoing the amounts will perhaps be unequal I do give
they shall be made equal by money & then all the remainder of my
estate to be equally divided between my aforesaid Children viz John H.
Marshall A Frank H. Kelly Melinda & Susanna & Anne

Item 6th In the event I should die after a crop has been commenced it is my
will that every thing shall remain on the plantation until the
crop is harvested by this I mean after paying for the next crop has
commenced breaking up ground &c

Item 7th the property I give to my Daughter Susanna I hereby vest in the
hands of William Borden in Trust for his wife Susanna her
days & at her Death to be equally divided amongst all her children
the property I give to my Daughter Melinda I hereby vest in hands of
her Husband General Butler in Trust for her during life & at her death
equally divided amongst her children

The property I give to my Daughter Anne I hereby vest in the hands
of William P. Wellerby her Husband in Trust for his wife Anne
wife & at her Death to be equally divided amongst her children

Item 8th I hereby nominate & appoint my son Frank W. Hardman of this my last
Will & Testament to witness where I have executed this my will
the 22nd Day of March 1855

said Isaac Borden deceased publickly & before the witness
wishing to be his agent Wellerby & Taylor and that they
disagreeded the same of Wellerby in the presence of
each other & the Taylor & at his request they between
them sat at the house of Edward Wellerby & Taylor
between 1st & 2nd October in open land & July 1855
