

In the Name of God amen I Isaac Minigh being Ed & Sane but of sound Mind & disposing Memory thanks be given to God being to mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed unto men to die Do therefore this my last will & Testament that first & chiefly I give & bequeath my soul to God who gave it & my Body to the Earth from whom it was taken to be buried there in burial nothing doubting but that I shall receive it again at the general Resurrection by the mighty Power of God & as touching what worldly estate I have placed God to bless me with I give & Dispose of in the following manner first I give & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary my dear Loving her Natural life all the tract of Land Wharvon I now live with all the appurtenances thereto belonging with all the effects of Every Kind & also all my house hold & Kitchen Furniture with all & every other species of Property of Every Kind whatsoever and at her Death I give & bequeath the whole of the above named Property of Every Kind unto my Daughter Elizabeth Minigh forever but Provided my Wife Mary Minigh should be the longest Live then she is to have the Right to Dispose of the whole as she may see fit & Reason but Provided my Daughter Elizabeth Minigh should be the longest Live then she is to have the final Disposition of the whole lastly I appoint James Hargrave my sole & lawful Executor of this my last will & Testament
