County State of Georgia, being very sick & weak in body
but of perfect mind & sound Judgment do make & declare
this to be my last will & testament. First I recommend my
soul into the, almighty God, who gave it & body to the dust
to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the
discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the gene-
ral Resurrection to receive the same when last shall rise
again unite again & touching such worldly things as it
shall please God, to bless me with in this life I devise & dispose
of in the following manner - (viz), after all dues & debts and
demands being legally discharged, 1st I give & bequeath to my
well beloved wife my loved in Jasper County & the plantation
we now live on with three negroes named Tom, Laura, & Billa.
with all the stock of all kinds & all the land & 8

Furniture of all kinds, whatever, her paying all due debts also to raise & educate my children in the best manner she can the remainder of my negroes to be equally divided between my ^{four} children Paschal M. Allison, Lewis Deane Allison & Samuel Wilson Allison & James Deaton Allison my wife to have the care of my childrens negroes until my children come of age or till they marry & do hereby constitute & ordain my, Elisha Allison & Samuel Wilson executors of my last will & testament all other wills heretofore made by me are null & void this I do ratify & confirm to be last will & testament in which I have herunto set my hand & seal this nineteenth of February eighteen hundred & eighty nine 1818
