 I James Carroll of the county & State above being weak in body but
 of perfect mind memory & senses be given to God calling unto mind the
 mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die do make my last Will & Testament that is to say principally first
 of all I give & recommend my soul unto the hands of almighty God
 who gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in
 a Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors
 First, I give & bequeath Sarah Carroll my loving wife an negro woman
 and by the name of, her case & those I'm owes six cows & calves all
 my plantation ~~lands~~ ^{with} all the household & kitchen furniture
 to have the best & serving for a natural life
 secondly, I give & bequeath to my loving five children, viz, three sons
 Jack Ahe, & Harry, to be divided equally among them. Also a tract of
 land granted to John Tidwell lying & being in the twelfth
 district of Wilkinson in the State of Georgia. Also one other tract
 of land granted to Sam. Poffin in the twelfth district of
 Wilkinson also part of a tract of land being lying in York
 county South Carolina, also part of a tract of land granted to
 John Carroll also part of a tract of land granted to John
 Humphries, also part of a tract of land granted to John

Keystadale lying being in York county South Carolina also all my seed cotton to put up to sale, also some stock of cattle to be sold at best advantage, also two horses, all the above property to be equally divided among my five children at the expiration of six years from this date, & I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke, disannul all every other form of testament wills or legacies, bequest & executors by me in any way by me before named Will & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th of March in the year of our lord 1813
