first. I give & bequeath unto my son
Samuel Glenn all that parcel a tract of
lands on which I now live being embracing
the old Boice Survey & the two other surveys
adjoining it and I bequeath to my self
all being in the County & State aforesaid
on Walnut Creek and its branches and
adjoining the lands of Mary Ann & others
thereof. If I should not pay in full

my death and the death of my wife Elizabeth
I give to my Daughters Sarah Eliza
Elizabeth Emily & Letitia one Hundred
dollars each

Third - after my death and the death of
my beloved wife my Son James R. Glen
shall go into possession of the above described
premises my Daughters having received
the sums I have severally given them
above - I wish my perishable property
and the proceeds thereof together with all
the property both real and personal after
my death just debts are paid to be

divided by three disinterested persons
viz equal Shares to be drawn for by my
min Children viz Mary Gabe Sam R. Glen
John W. Glen Joshua N. Glen Eliza
Sowell Elizabeth Harrington Emily Glen
James R. Glen & Letitia Glen and
Glen to each of them the Share they shall
so draw for themselves or by their proper
representations

Lastly I constitute & appoint John W. Glen
& Joshua N. Glen my Sons Executors of
this my last will and testament - In
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 2nd day of December
1835 Signed Sealed and acknowledged
