 mortality of my body knowing that is appointed for all persons one
 to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament in man
 of form following viz, first of all I recommend my soul into the
 hands of God that gave it & my body to the dust to be decently
 buried by my hereafter named executor & as touching my
 worldly estate wherewith it hath been pleased God to
 bless me I give & bequeath it as follows viz, first it is
 my will & desire that all my last debts should be
 paid by my executors out of my estate
 Then I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy
 Thormond my negro fellow Dick Negro woman named
 Dick & the the plantation Shougott of Nicholas
 Tuttle Also the stock house hold & kitchen furniture
 & plantation tools, which at her death is to be equally
 divided amongst the children
 Then I give to my beloved son William Thormond one my
 boy named Charles, Also I give to my beloved son
 Phillip Thormond one negro girl named Esther
 Also I give to my beloved son John Thormond one my
 boy named David, Also I give to my beloved son
 Jefferson one negro girl named Filly, Also I give
 my beloved son Flisha one negro girl named Fanny
 Also I give to my beloved son Patton one negro girl
 named Lydia Lydia which negroes the afore named
 children shall have as they become of age

and if either of the childrens negroes die before they
 come of age that the other children shall throw in
 an equal part to make them all on a like footing
 I do hereby ordain constitute & appoint my beloved wife
 Nancy Therman & my trusty friend Edward Ware
 my lawful & sole executors to this my last will and
 testament & all others by me made to be null & void
 to all intents & purposes I do hereby solemnly declar-
 e ratify & affirm this to be my only last will & testam-
 in witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
