In full testimony whereof ~~I have~~ I have set my hand & affixed my seal this twentieth day of August one thousand eight hundred & four signed & acknowledged James Orr ^{testator} in presence of Mr. the good people of color here in Michael Dickson the third, Benjamin Echols
