 My last will & Testament

Item 1st I give my Body to the grave until the morning of Resurrection & then
 to the Lord

Item 2nd I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Willborn During her natural
 life time the said plantation I now live together with the plantation the
 Farming plantation house and plantation furniture all of my stock of hogs
 Cattle & Horses including all personal property

Item 3rd It is my will that my first debt be paid out of my Effects or as my
 Executors may think most advantageous

Item 4th It is my will & desire that all my personal Effects should belong to the said my
 wife Elizabeth During her life time if it should be her choice

Item 5th It is my will that my sons James I Willborn & John I Willborn & John Joseph
 Cook should remain on the premises & take care of their Mother & Hannah
 Willborn as becoming affectionate sons & Brothers & if they do I wish for
 them to have all they can make here above specified equally then &
 when either of the aforesaid James John & John Joseph Cook should
 think them unfit to have & possess I wish to take care & support the
 Mother & Hannah Willborn During their lives I thus wish myself
 to sell my land & estate aforesaid & live on the proceeds

Item 6th It is my will that William Willborn now residing from the White Spring branch
 to where the old line crosses the Creek then up the Dry Branch
 to the Big by dam

Item 7th It is my will that M. H. Willborn son Simon should have the land
 whereon said Willborn now resides beginning on the bank on day side
 there to a Black Jack on Rocky down near A. J. Willborns shop then
 a north course to the lower River bank then down said bank to the
 mouth of White Spring Branch

Item 8th The land I purchased in the second town is the land not sold to Ed
 Willborn son & M. H. Willborn son Simon the Remainder of my land
 when I now reside

Item 9th I wish Emily Cook to Remain with my wife During her life &
 be held with as one of the family & if Emily Remaining with the family
 During my wifes absence I wish her to have a bed

Item 10th It is my will that if the aforesaid James I Willborn & John I Willborn & John
 Joseph Cook should die & my wife perform what is beyond on them in the 5th
 Item as aforesaid taking care & supporting of their Mother & Hannah Willborn
 During their lives then the Remainder to be equally divided between them then

Item 11th It is my will that my Executors while alive attend to the said debt that is due
 in Court & if they should discover the debt in dispute the law that should
 be made according to the agreement between me & B. F. Boyson and my
 possession of Mr. Madsen should be given to A. J. Willborn son James
 & William in hand on its value

Item 12th It is my will that James I Willborn & B. F. Boyson by my Executor
 to this my last will given under my hand & seal this 3rd Day of May 1857
