

George / I James Wheeler of the county & State aforesaid being 351
Jackson County Do I solemnly swear of my approaching end March 1854
My last Will & Testament
It is my Will that all my just debts be paid
I give to my son John Wheeler children the tract of land to which I
am now living
I have heretofore given my son David Wheeler the tract of land
I now live on & it is that my Will that said David shall have
said tract of land as his full share of my Estate
I give to my Daughter Mary Wheeler my say Mann on land & half
five of the just share of my one fourth But husband & personal
all my household furniture of all kinds together with all the cotton
& half the land & wood that I may have at my Death both in
the full & feather
The Balance of my Property of all kinds I wish to be Equally
divided between all my children within the exception of my son
David Wheeler who has as above stated received his full & entire
portion of my Estate
I constitute & appoint my son John Wheeler & my son David
Executors of this my last Will & Testament
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 15 day
of May 1854
