Jackson County & said State & County being of advanced age & knowing  
that I must shortly Depart from this world Deem it Right & Proper to call on  
myself & my Family that I do make a Disposition of the  
Property which the Providence has blessed me I therefore make  
this My last Will & Testament hereby Revoking & annulling all others  
hereof made by me

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give & Direct that my body be buried in a decent & Christian manner  
convenient to my living time in life my soul I trust shall return to  
rest with God who gave it

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I give & Direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my family  
known after my death I am overlooking my creditors & the delay of them  
Rightly especially as there is no necessity for delay

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give & Direct to my beloved wife Elizabeth White one dollar in cash

4<sup>th</sup> I give & Direct to my son John White one \$24 & nothing & nothing else

5<sup>th</sup> the rest of my Property both Real & Personal wherein & whatsoever else  
be I Direct & bequeath to my Daughter Naomi Gray wife of James Gray  
Gray to her & her heirs forever & my Daughter Augusta Harris wife  
of Walton Harris to her & her heirs forever to be divided equally between  
the two last mentioned in Item fifth

6<sup>th</sup> I constitute & appoint my Son in law James Gray son in law  
Walton Harris my Executor to this my last will & Testament the 23  
Day of August 1818
