bed do make this my last Will & Testament in
witness whereof I have subscribed my name and underwritten these
words I have following that is to say the Plantation or tract of
Land whereon I now reside I will & bequeath unto my youngest
son James D. Henderson with this express Condition that is to
say of said Plantation until he accumulates property enough
to purchase himself it is further my Will & Desire that my
son above mentioned take care of my white Beloved wife
Margaret Henderson jointly during her natural life I will and
bequeath unto my white Beloved Daughter Rebecca Henderson
one Slave Man Call I will & bequeath unto my white Beloved wife
Margaret Henderson the Bed & bed cloaths also a woman
Saddle the Saddle of my Property I will & bequeath for
it to be sold & the Proceeds to be Equally Divided among
all my Children with the Exception of my two Sons Andrew
& James D. Henderson above named Last by I do hereby
appoint my Sons Andrew & James D. Henderson Executors
of this my Last Will & Testament
and I do hereby Make Void all other Wills by me heretofore
made & do declare this to be my Last Will & Testament
