& prefer both as my Family & myself that I should make a disposition of the
property which I possess I therefore make this my last will & Testament
That I desire & direct that my Body be buried in a Burial & Christian Interment
suitable to my Circumstances & Condition in life

I then I desire & direct that all my Just Debts be paid as soon as possible by the Executors here
after named out of the Effects or proceeds of the same
I then I give & bequeath to my self & my heirs all the tract of land between Seven Bay
with all the appurtenances thereto containing fifty acres to have & hold during her
Natural life or widowhood & after her Death or Marriage to be sold & Equally
Divided amongst my lawful heirs also to keep all the stock & house Furniture
plantation Tools & provisions for the benefit of herself & the support of the children
the names of which is here annexed (Elizabeth Harvey) (Mary Ann) (Elizabeth
Marion) (John Wiley) (Richard King) (Franklin Harrison)

I then I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Ann A certain Iron Grate told known
by the name of Marions to have as her own property
I then I hereby appoint James & Henson & my self Executors & Administrators of
this my last will & Testament this January 25th 1856

Second shall & declared by John Mung as his last will & Testament in the presence
of us the subscribers who subscribed our names hereto in the presence of said Testator
at his Request & on the request of each other
