 - 4th I give & bequeath unto my wifes daughter Ann Weston dollars in money
 - 5th I will & bequeath unto my three children John Orr Jr, Rebecca
Weston, & Susan H. Miller all my property both real & personal
to be equally divided between them having no reference to my
ability, that I have given & delivered to them before this date
all before this division shall be made my executor will
pay all my Just debts & the legacies left in money to my wife
then children the debts & money legacies paid by settling my
property, my executor may think best it is any way they may
think best it most advantageous to my estate
- I do name & appoint John Orr Jr & James Ware my
executors to this my last will & testament in witness whereof I have
