 do make this my last will & testament. I first devote my soul to the
 almighty God who gave it & rest my body to be buried in a decent
 Christian burial according to the direction of my executors. And after
 all my Just debt being paid & funeral expenses, I bequeath my only
 girl named Phillis, & all my movable property to & for the use of her
 said widowhood. I leave & bequeath to my son Joseph all the land
 whereon I now live three hundred & forty four Acres with the Mills
 & all the appurtenances belonging thereto. I leave & bequeath to my
 daughter Hannah Caldwell the first child that Phillis has or one
 hundred dollars, & likewise bequeath to my son John if ever he returns
 one hundred dollars, at the expiration of two years from the date.
 I leave & bequeath to my daughter Catherine & Sarah six cows & calves each
 or cattle to that value to each of them a good riding horse or one hundred
 head of hogs one negro child or one hundred dollars & this and no
 other I follow to be my last will & testament. I further allow and

appoint my wife Hon Joseph to be my whole State executor, I do
