Jackson County being of sound mind
and disposing memory, but my body on the decline
and taking into consideration the uncertainty of life
and all future events and the certainty of death
do Ordain this my last Will & Testament (This)
I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary
Robinson my entire Estate both real & personal
for her use, management and benefit during
her natural life. And I wish & desire for her to
continue to let the two orphan children who now
live run live with her until they shall become of
lawful age to wit John Wood & Frances Wood
I Give & bequeath unto my nephews
James Wood & William Wood five hundred
Dollars each also my nephew Henry Smith
fifteen hundred Dollars also to my two nieces
the Daughters of my sister Smith of Franklin
County Georgia five hundred Dollars each to
John Wood & Frances Wood one thousand
Dollars each to be paid out of my estate

after the decease of my beloved wife and app-
 -ointed wife Mary Robinson. And it is my will
 that my beloved wife dispose of the balance of my
 estate except the above specific Legacies as she
 may desire and determine. It is further my
 wish and desire that if any of my Negroes
 should prove after my death to be disobedient
 or troublesome to my wife she may put them
 up to public sale to the highest bidder and sell
 at her discretion I further bequeath unto
 Mary which Smith James Smith Miller
 Smith David Smith and Israel Roberts
 Wood One hundred & dollars each after
 death of said wife to pay as the above Mary
 Legacies to be paid
