state of health sound of perfect in mind & recollection thanks be  
to God, but calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once  
to die ~~knowing~~<sup>knowing</sup> the mortality of the body do make this my last  
Will & Testament, that is to say principally first of all I give and  
recommend my soul to God & my body to the earth to be buried in  
usual Christian form at the discretion of my executor, and  
touching of my worldly estate, I give & dispose of the same  
in the following manner & form first of all that all my  
~~debts~~<sup>debts</sup> be paid out of my estate & the rest to be dis-  
posed of in the following manner, *viz*,  
first I give & bequeath to Rebecca my beloved wife all  
my estate real & personal during natural life  
then to be equally divided among my children as follow  
*viz*, George Humphreys, Shadrach Humphreys, Uriah  
Humphreys, Hannah Jackson, Judah Sparks, & Rebecca  
Willingham, each an equal share, whereas my daughter  
Sarah Harey is deceased, I will to her one Shilling Sterling  
only, but nevertheless I will that her children have one share  
equally divided amongst them all, And also my daughter  
Mary Jackson being deceased I will that her two sons  
Elijah & Frederick Jackson have one share equally dis-  
posed between them, all to be punctually paid by my exec-  
utors as the children severally come of age -  
I also nominate & appoint my beloved sons George Humphreys  
Shadrach Humphreys, & Uriah Humphreys my executors to the  
my last Will & Testament, & knowing this & no other  
of Will's last of me made to be my last Will & Testament  
In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day  
of August 1807
