Hannah Postaire, I give & bequeath the sum of one hundred
thirty dollars over & above her equal division of all the
residue of my estate, after the payment of my just debts
Item 3rd To my sons Jacob Postaire & Matthew Postaire, to my
daughters, Elizabeth Postaire, Peggy Postaire Hannah
Postaire, aforesaid, and Kelly J. Post, I give & bequeath
all the residue of my estate to be divided among them
& share alike

Item 4th I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife Sarah
Postaire, my son in law John Post, & Richard W.
Pemberton the executors of this my last will & testament
