of sound mind & memory & knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die do make constitute & ordain this to be my last will and
testament & hereby revoking disannulling & setting aside all former
will or wills by me heretofore made
I give I will that all my just debts be specially & punctually
paid, I leave I will to my daughter Ursil the plantation
whereon I reside containing two hundred acres & go I will to
my daughter Ursil one partridge & promise to a certain

dark Brown two year old horse, I will to Nancy Mabee our
 negro girl named Clarissa two feather beds & furniture. I will it is
 further my will & desire that ^{all} the balance of my estate both real & personal
 consisting of tract of land in Madison County containing 440 acres
 Slaves, Stock household & Kitchen furniture to should be equally
 divided amongst my children (except as is herebefore excepted)
 viz, Patsy Parsons, Isham Barker, Sally Polk, Gray Barker, Lewis
 Barker, Polly Phillips, Betsey Chandler, Cillar Polk, Eldridge
 Barker, & Urvil Barker. It further my will & desire that my chil-
 = dren, hereafter named should not be entitled to a dividend in the
 tract of land above referred to in Madison County (viz); Lewis Barker
 Eldridge Barker & Urvil Barker. It is further my will & desire that
 my children aforesaid should agree in a division of the property with-
 out it being put to sale. It further my will that that part of my prop-
 = erty that may fall as heretofore excepted to my daughters shall be
 theirs during their natural lives, & at their decease to belong to their
 lawful children severally in an equal division, & should it happen
 to my executor hereafter named that my daughters aforesaid or
 their husbands any, or any person who shall should be improperly
 wasting or destroying the property above referred to, It is my will
 that the lawful executor should by them be resorted to,
 to restrain such waste, And I do hereby constitute & appoint
 Parker Chandler, Isham Barker, Lewis Barker, Gray Barker
 & Eldridge Barker, my lawful executors to execute this
 my last will & testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & seal this fourteenth day of March in the year of
 our Lord eight hundred & eighteen signed sealed & acknowledged

 Samuel Wilson of the State & County aforesaid considering
 the uncertainty of this mortal life & being of sound mind
 & memory blessed be almighty God for the same do make
 & publish this my last will & testament in manner & form
 following that is to say first I give & bequeath unto my single
 daughters to wit, Mary, Liley, Lydia, Jane, & Harriette on
 their marriage or on their arrival to the age of twenty ^{now} one
 years each & every one of my ~~said~~ ^{now} unmarried daughters one
 negro to be partitioned & delivered by my after named executor
 & hereafter which negro when delivered to each of my above named
 daughters is to be valued by three free holders of said County
 nominated by the Court of Ordinance of said County & the person
 appointed to value said negro will say upon oath what the
 difference of price & value is between the negro partitioned
 out & delivered as aforesaid by my executor & hereafter
 a negro girl of ^{the age of} eighteen years of good quality & if the appraiser
 and of opinion that the negro so partitioned out is of less value
 than a negro girl of the age of eighteen years of good quality
 my executor & executor shall pay the difference in money
 to each of my above named daughters at the time of delivery
 of the negro & if the said appraisers are of opinion that the
 negro delivered as aforesaid is of more value than a negro
 girl of the age of eighteen years of good quality then
 each of my above named daughters shall pay the said
 difference in money to my executor & executor
 I do also give & bequeath unto my daughters Mary
 Liley Lydia Jane & Harriette each of them & have
