I James Carroll of the county & State above being weak in body but
of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God calling unto mind the
mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
die do make my last will & Testament that is to say principally first
of all I give & recommend my soul unto the hands of almighty God
who gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in
a Christian like manner at the dispositions of my executors
First, I give & bequeath Sarah Carroll my loving wife one negro woman
and by the name of Corcease & three men six cows & calves all
my plantation lands ^{including} all the household & kitchen furniture
to have the hold & dwelling for natural life

Secondly, I give & bequeath to my surviving five children, viz, three sons
Jack, Abe, Harry, to be divided equally among them Also a tract of
land granted to John Caldwell lying & lying in the twelfth
district of Wilkinson in the state of Georgia Also one other tract
of land granted to Sam. Little in the twentieth district of
Wilkinson also part of a tract of land being lying in York
county South Carolina, also part of a tract of land granted to
John Carroll also part of a tract of land granted to John
Humphries, also part of a tract of land granted to James
