 William Jarrett my sole Executor to this my last will & testament to manage
 the same whole during his life for said children & mine that it be
 Equally Divided between the above named children if they all be alive
 or any of them that may be alive at his Death in testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 2nd Day of April 1856
