 -ance and sustenance and that of the said negroes
 during my natural life all which is to take
 effect immediately after my death and not
 before all of the foregoing gifts is to be upon the
 express condition that the said James Morris do pay
 to his sister Mary McAnson if she shall then be
 alive or to her children if she be dead in twelve
 months after my death the sum of three hundred
 dollars to be equally divided among them
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this 21st day of January 1835
