 if any and all my Stock of cattle & hogs and all my house
 hold furniture Beds & bedding bed clothing & all other appur-
 tenances together with all my Table Furniture and all & Every
 thing & things whereof I am seized in Right of all what
 I have to him & his heirs & assigns forever on condition
 nevertheless of his continuing to live in the House with me
 & take care of Mountain Support & to remain me in my
 old & Inferior situation during my life time but should
 he quit living with me & fail to comply with the above
 condition then his Right to the above Property to be for-
 feited & this Deed to be of no Effect in Law.
