 hold furniture Beds & bedding bed Cloaths & all their appur-
 tenances together with all my Table Furniture and all & every
 thing & things whereof I am seized in Right of all which
 I give to him & his heirs & assigns forever on Condition
 nevertheless of his continuing to live in the House with me
 & take Care of & maintain Support & Sustain me in my
 old & Inferior Situation During my Life time but should
 be quit living with me & fail to comply with the above
 conditions then his Right to the above Property to be for-
 feited & this Deed to be of no Effect in Law
