 testament in manner & form following
 Item my will is first that all my property I shall hereafter
 mention first be valued by ^{who may be} ~~my~~ order for that purpose
 and then the property to be divided amongst my heirs which
 I shall hereafter mention by the valuation or price set thereon
 by appraisers if the Legates can agree in such division
 but if they the said Legates cannot agree in taking the property
 at the appraisement as aforesaid then my will is that all the
 property hereafter to be mentioned be sold at public sale
 & the money which arise therefrom be equally between
 my daughter Esther Graham, Isaac Borders, John Borders
 Nathaniel Dixon Stephen Borders Phile Borders & Ruth
 Borders after first giving my wife Mary Borders her portion
 which is to be equal to two of the ^{other} Legates Also my will
 is that before the division is made as before mentioned
 after the value of my property being ascertained that my
 daughter Margaret Click shall have four dollars to be paid
 her by my executors hereafter to be mentioned out of the said
 appraisement as her Legacy The property which is to be divided
 in manner & form as before mentioned is as follows 1822
 Three hundred & twenty three acres of land together with all
 the improvement thereon also five negroes names Bob Joe
 Duns & Abraham & horses also nine head of horns as also all
 my stock of cattle sheep hogs & geese together with all my
 household furniture & every thing of all kinds that I possess
 Also one Wagon & gear & one still also all my money
 together with all the debts that is due me
 Item I give & bequeath all the above mentioned property
 as before mentioned to my heirs as I have named and do
 make this my last will & testament I also appoint &
 ordain my wife Mary Borders & John Borders as my
 executors to this my last will & testament to act & divide
 as I have therein directed to have full power to collect all
 my debts & settle with all the Legates herein named
 This my last will & testament signed with my hand

and sealed with my seal this 7th day of September 1804

Jackson County being in perfect sound mind & memory & recollection
 & calling to mind the uncertainty of life do make this my last
 Will & Testament & desiring all others do confirm & ratify this as
 my last will & Testament, to wit, First I resign my soul into
 the hands of my gracious & wise Creator trusting he will
 dispose of the same in mercy, secondly I submit my body to the
 dust to be buried in a plain & decent manner there to rest till
 the morning of the resurrection Thirdly I dispose of my worldly
 goods in the following manner — First I give & bequeath
 to my beloved wife Meriam Bagby the land & plantation
 whereon I now live with all the negroes that is not already
 given to Wm. Tom. Charlotte, Frank, Eave, Delphie, Lydia,
 Rudy, Lucy, & Isaac, also all my stock of horses cattle hogs and
 goats & sheep also all my household furniture & working tools
 Also all bonds & notes out of which she is to pay all my debts
 which I leave to her until my youngest child
 comes of age at which time I wish an equal division to be
 made of all my property among my sons only except such
 as I shall will to my wife & Daughters to wit, I give and
 bequeath to my loving wife during natural life the land
 & plantation whereon I now live with the household furniture
 Also four cows & calves two horses half the hogs sheep & goats
 I shall the working tools also three negroes to wit, Lydia
