

George in the Name of God Amen I the undersigned Clerk of said Court Jackson County & County being in public health but of sound & disposing mind Reason & Memory and I do hereby certify that they said Deed & Deeds of George that I should make a Repose of the property with which a last part has been made so therefore under this my last Will & Testament

Item I I give & bequeath to my wife Sarah A. Will all the share in the property conveyed by her to John Willard in a Deed of Trust Dated on the 10th of March last for her use & benefit the following property to wit the same for her said husband & her heirs which I received with my said wife at the time of our marriage

Item I I give & bequeath to My Wife Sarah A. Will all the share in the property to which I am Entitled by Virtue of the Will of William D. Willard & in the Event that said Wife shall hereafter be Stricken by my Executor herein after named shall pay over to her said share in said property and said Wife with the legal Interest accruing thereon

Item I It is my Will & Desire that My Executor herein after named shall collect all Debts & Claims or Demands Due Me as shown as possible and that he shall also all of my Estate both Real & Personal including my Rightful share in the Estate of My father David Willard Deceased on which I have as he may think best on the first Tuesday in January next after my Death at the Bar of the Court here in Jackson County after first leaving two Months Notice thereof in one of the newspapers of this State & I desire my Estate to Cash as speedily as possible

Item I I give & bequeath to My Friend Dr. John M. Echols Jr. My black horse & the sum of five hundred Dollars in Cash to be paid to him by My Executor out of the funds arising from the sale of the property specified in the third item or Clause of this Will

Item I I give & bequeath to My friend Nathaniel H. Ponding all of the balance of the Money arising from the sale of the property included & specified in the third item of this Will & all the Rest & Residue of my Estate of whatever Kind Character or Description to which I may be Entitled at my Death

Item I It is my Will & Desire that all my just Debts be paid by my Executor out of the Cash & proceeds of my property or Estate before they accrue on said Estate previous to the first Day of January next after my Death & in the Event that said sum shall

be insufficient for the payment of said Debts then I am that I am at any future time unpaid out of said funds as a fund I shall be paid out of the residue hereby given to said Nathaniel H. Ponding
 Item I I hereby constitute & appoint my Executor & worthy friend Andrew M. Parker Executor of this my last Will & Testament this 21st Day of June 1855
