 estate, but upon further consideration I give each of them
 one dollar more, secondly I give & bequeath to my
 beloved son Willm fifty acres of land beginning at the
 upper corner in the river & running up the road including
 his own plantation, thirdly I give & bequeath to my beloved
 daughter Eliza Rowland fifty acres of land beginning
 at the road adjoining Rowland now live thence to the upper

upper corner being Pearce thence out for quantity with also my
two horses & all my cattle of every description (the oxen excepted),

Fourthly, I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Elizabeth Jones, as
child & heir the remainder of my tract of land including my plan-
tation with all the working tools & things belonging & also my some
more & cett. Fifthly, I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter
Abisha Beauchamp my negro fellows called Ann & after
paying all my just debts, I finally & hereby appoint Isaac
Cowan my executor to this my last will & Testament hereby
revoking all will or wills by me heretofore made — In
testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
14th day of September 1815 Signed sealed & delivered in
