County of Jackson State of Georgia do make this my
will testament in manner & form following, I give my
soul to almighty God; hoping for pardon for all my
sins, through the sufferings of my Lord, & saviour Jesus
Christ, & for my worldly estate which it hath pleased
God, to bestow on me, I do give in manner & form
following, I give to my son Nathaniel Meghe five shillings
sterling with all that he has rec'd. of me to him & his
for ever. I give to my son Jesse Meghe one negro boy
named Simon & eighty pounds to be paid in cash at his
shillings each to him & his heirs forever. I give to my
daughter Patsy Meghe a negro boy & a feather bed
and a black horse named Gault & eighty pounds

to be paid in dollars at his shillings each during his life and
at his death to be equally divided between my four sons Jesse
Robert Osborn & Solomon to them and their heirs forever
I give to my son Nathaniel a negro man named Nat
born father & paritural. & eighty pounds to be paid in
dollars at six shillings each to him & his heirs forever
I give to my son Osborn a negro boy named
Pete & eighty pounds to be paid in dollars at six shillings
each to him & his heirs forever. I give to my son Solomon
a negro boy named Munchester & eighty
pounds to be paid in dollars at six shillings each
to him & his heirs forever. I give to my son Mil. a negro
five shillings sterling to him and his heirs forever
I give all the rest of my estate be it of what kind
or quality so ever to be divided between my four sons Jesse
Osborn & Solomon equally. I do appoint my son Jesse
Nathaniel & my friend John Shepard to be the executor
of this my last Will & Testament in which things I have
set my hand & seal this 15th day of August 1803
