 Item 3rd I give & bequeath to my Daughter Susan Shattuck My Negro boy Chesnut
 Item 4th I give & bequeath to my son-in-law John L. Williamson on my Negro boy Darius
 Item 5th I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca during her Natural life
 if it should please God she should dwell on the plantation where
 I now reside With all the farming Tools hogs Pigs & cattle of all kind
 Hens and Poultry furniture together with the following Negroes to
 wit Aggy Jade Catherine Delina Mary Lion & Anderson

Item 6th It is my will that John L. Williamson attend to see that my wife
 Wants for nothing that can be procured that will render her comfortable
 & happy her remaining days

Item 7th At the death of my wife it is my will that all the property in which
 she has a life estate contained in the fifth item of this will together
 With the income thereof be the property of John L. Williamson & after
 her death I hereby give & bequeath the same to the said John L. William-
 son & I hereby make it obligatory on the said John L. to take care of
 my love all my years Aggy & Jade

Item 8th If I die in Debt My Executors & Administrators shall have full power to sell
 such property as they think best to pay them off to be taken from
 that which is my wife in the fifth item of this will and out of the Sale
 of the same of that property my Executors shall pay the Moneys
 Legally Contained in the second item of this will

Item 9th I hereby nominate & appoint my wife Rebecca Shattuck & my son-in-law
 John L. Williamson my Executors & Administrators to carry into effect this will
 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the third
 Day of January Eighteen Hundred & forty five
