interior clothing in my Parthens Estate when there coming to be a division
of said Estate together with so that money debts & accounts I may have at my death
And I hereby revoke all other Wills & Testaments heretofore made by me &
appoint my Sister Mary & Sharpe my sole Executors to fully execute & carry
out this my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 16 Day of March 1857
