In the name of God I now, I John Carmichael of the State Georgia
 & Jackson County being in a very low state of health of body but of perfect
 mind & memory thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mortality
 of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make
 & ordain this my last will & testament, that is to say principally & first of
 all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave
 it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of my executor nothing doubting but at the
 general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
 power power of God, And as touching such worldly estate wherewith I
 has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same
 in the following manner & form. First I give & bequesth to my grand
 son John Carmichael Jun^r son of Duncan Carmichael the sum of
 one hundred dollars of good & lawful money of this State to be raised
 & lived out of my estate, at the age of twenty one provided he
 should live to that age, And if not the money to be equally divided
 between the rest of the lawful heirs. If Duncan Carmichael
 should not come nor none of his heirs & make a declaration for
 his part of my estate before his son the above named John
 Carmichael Jun^r comes of age my executor is authorized to pay
 the said Duncan's part to his son John Carmichael Jun^r & also
 I allow my daughter Sarah Stiles to take a third of my house
 & the appraisment, My will further is that all my estate real
 & personal shall be sold at the discretion of my executor John
 Carmichael, Whom I appoint my whole & sole executor of this my
