Jackson County I Observe I am of the State and County aforesaid
being in a low state of health but sound and perfect in Mind and
Memory and knowing that it is appointed to all men to die do make this
My last will and Testament to wit

1st In obedience to the last will and Testament of my late Husband Phillip
Ryan & died I request that my wages wife remain on the plantation
upon which I now live during their living under the superintendence
of John Dancer & Nathaniel Moore and for the net proceeds of their
Labour to be applied to the use of my Daughter Elizabeth Hall
and in case of her death the use of my Son Whitehead Ryan I further
wish that if my son Whitehead Ryan dying it shall be supported
by the Labour of said wages and then the proceeds to be applied
as above directed

2^d for the use of the said wages I give all my plantation to my
one slave Mare My Interest in a last & best oxen belonging to Phillip
Ryan and myself together with a flax wheel and loom My present
Stock of Hogs & two Molted cows

3rd I give to Sarah Dyer Thirtypen Dollars being a balance of fifty
Dollars left her by the will of her Grand father

4th To my grand son Phillip Mann I give twenty Dollars

5th to my grand daughter Susan Hampton I give my household
furniture and my bed also back back or forty of land as may
be drawn by me in the contemplated Land lottery to her &
her heirs also one cow & calf

6th To my grand son Phillip Hampton a horse & saddle and a good
sheet of Cloth to be given him on his becoming eighteen years of age
7th I request that one bed may be left in the house where I am

2^o I request that all my Land & Chattels be given by Will
and dying in 2d Dist Party County be sold by White
Ryan and the Proceeds to be Equally Divided between her
and his Sister Elizabeth Hall

3^o I request that all my horses & Cattle which are not otherwise
designed of be sold & the Money applied to the payment of
Debts & to the use of my Daughter Elizabeth Hall

4^o I desire that the part of Land upon which I now dwell
after the Death of my Negroes be Divided between John
and Deborah Moon

5^o I hereby appoint John Warren and Deborah Moon
-taries of this my last Will and Testament - I witness that
I have signed to it with my hand and seal this 8 Day of May
one thousand eight hundred & Thirty five
