 may find stand in need, of the same
 2nd After the death of my wife I desire that my negroes shall
 remain on my land & have the privilege of having their own
 time & to be under the control of William Matthews & Thomas
 Mitchell two of my executors herein after named the hire to be
 distributed among such of my grand children as my wife
 by will may direct
 3rd I desire that my wife shall give unto my two grand daughters
 Susannah Sampkin, & Sarah Haver fifty dollars each
 if she can conveniently spare the same but if she cannot
 then my surviving executor after the death of my wife to see
 her part of my will is complied with
 4th I desire there shall be no appraisement or sale of my estate
 to be managed by my wife & other executors in such
 manner as they may deem most proper
 by appointing my wife Obedience my whiteo Ryan
