 this my last will and Testament—

 furniture and all the balance of my household and kitchen
 furniture—

I also give to Nancy Spence one Negro woman named Dimp—
 I also give to Rachel Drewell one sorrel mare Colt—

Georgia } Personally appeared before us Jacob Weiner and
 Jackson County } Abram Weiner, and after being duly sworn
 faith that they were subscribing witnesses to the within will, and
 that they saw Rachel Wallace sign (by her marks) her name thereto
 and that they subscribed their names as witnesses in her presence
 and in the presence of each other, and that she was at the time
 of doing the same of sound and disposing memory.
