debts be paid - Secondly, to my son James Rogers
& beneath my negro man Bob - also two oxen and
half of the increase of all the stock since he commenced

living with me. also one Bed & furniture -
 Thirdly, To my daughter Rhoda Rodden I bequeath one Bed
 and furniture - Fourthly, to my Grand daughter Rhoda
 Ann Kennedy I give one Bed and furniture -
 fifthly, to my daughter Mary B. Potts I give one Bed and
 furniture - also one large Pot - also one Bay Mare Called Coosa
 Sixthly - To my son Theophilus Rogers I give my negro Man Frank.
 Seventh - I desire that the balance of my property be disposed
 of by Sale, and after having been applied to the payment of
 my debts, if there should remain any, I desire that it be
 equally divided amongst my Grand Children. I also desire
 and by this will nominate and appoint my son James Rogers
 as executor to execute this instrument - In evidence whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th March
 in presence of - 7 - 1834
