

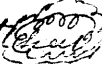
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In the name of God Amen

I Samuel Barnett son of the County of Jackson State of Georgia
Knowing that is appointed for all to die do make & constitute
this my last will & testament to wit; First my will is that my
Just Debt be paid out of my estate, I give unto my loving
wife Margaret during her natural life two negroes Rose
& Sibby my young horse mare called touch me not
two cows & calves six head of sheep with comfortable
support off my plantation I further give unto my said wife
absolutely all my household & kitchen furniture, further
I give to my son Samuel the tract of Land whereon I now live
with the reservation in favor of my wife for her support
therefrom, I give unto my said son Samuel after the death of
my wife the two negroes Rose & Sibby, I also give unto him all
the remaining part of my estate, In witness whereof I have
set my hand & seal this 28th June 1819—

the same in their presence, these deponents further say that
the said testator was to the best of their knowledge & belief of
