in particular I give & bequeath to my beloved  
wife Polly full & ample & complete possession  
of my land & plantation together with all the  
household & kitchen furniture of every kind  
whatever & all the plantation tools and its appur-  
tenances to go with all my stock of every  
kind Horses Cattle Hogs Sheep goats every thing  
under the name of either plantation stock  
except as hereafter explained to have & enjoy  
the same ample fully freely during their  
natural life and at her death for the whole  
of whatever may then exist as well as land or  
stock to be sold & equally divided among  
my children. And it is also my will  
and desire that my Girls & Corky & Polly  
Shewd receive as members of the  
family during the life of my said wife  
whatever they may need and it is my desire  
that my wife should give over to the children  
as a token she according to the circumstances  
can spare on this leaving of the family  
sup 2<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my son William  
my Young marr Colt & his p. bridle & saddle  
Bridle etc &c 3<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my son  
Sandford my Young Horse colt & p. and  
riding to buy him a tolerable good saddle  
& Bridle - And I do hereby constitute & appoint  
my beloved wife Polly the whole sole  
executrix of this my last will and testament

on Walnut creek with its branches and  
adjoining the lands of Wm. Evans, Sam & others  
seconds. If I should not pay it before
