will & testament. 1st It is my wish that my executors
hereon after named will pay all my last & lawful debts out of
that portion of my property which they my executors in their
wisdom may think proper to dispose of resulting to the interest
of my family which I leave behind. 2nd And after my
last demands are paid off, It is my wish that the remainder of my
property should be for the use of my wife Delilah Henderson & my
Children jointly during her life or widowhood, When either of
these events take place, it is then my will that all my property should
be divided among my Children equally.
3^d It is likewise my wish that both Children & property should
be kept together with my wife Delilah until my youngest
Child arrives to the age of twenty one on the plantation which I
bequeath unto them, at which time it is my wish & will that an
equal division of my property should take place between the legacies
both wife & Children provided my wife Delilah continue in her
widowhood, if not, only among my Children all of which it is my
wish should be bequeathed by my executors to the best of their knowledge
& wisdom tending to the welfare of my beloved family.
4th I nominate, constitute & appoint my wife Delilah Henderson
& my brother John R. Henderson my lawful executors to carry
this my last will into effect. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal the 13th day of December in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred thirty four
