 Forsyth County I Samuel H. Henderson of Jackson County
 I state aforswad being sick though of strong mind &
 good memory calling to mind the certainty of death & the brevity
 tainty of life do make this my last will & this only to be my last
 will & testament. 1st It is my wish that my executors
 herein after named will pay all my last & lawful debts, out of
 that portion of my property which they my executors in their
 wisdom may think proper to expose of reselling to the interest
 of my family which I leave behind. 2nd And after my
 last dividends are paid off. It is my wish that the remant of my
 property should be for the use of my wife Delilah Henderson & my
 Children Jointly during her life or widowhood. When either of
 these events take place, it is her my will that all my property should
 be divided among my Children equally.
 3^d It is likewise my wish that both Children & property should
 be kept together with my wife Delilah until my youngest
 Child arrives to the age of twenty one on the plantation where I
 bequeath unto them, at which time it is my wish to will that an
 equal division of my property should take place between the legatees,
 both wife & Children provided my wife Delilah continue in her
 widowhood, if not, only among my Children all of which it is my
 wish should be executed by my executors to the best of their knowledge
 & wisdom tending to the safety of my beloved family.
 4th I nominate constable to appoint my wife Delilah Henderson
 & my brother John H. Henderson my lawful executors to carry
 this my last will into effect. In Wilming whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & affixed my seal this 18th day of December in the
 year of our lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty four
