of Three Head and all my stock of Hogs and
my species of property that I may be possesd of
and moreover add that I have given all my
Children that portion of my little property
as I conceive they are entitled to upon the
principles of Equity & Justice

Lastly I do here by nominate and appoint my
Friend & Neighbor John Wofford my Executor
of this my last will & Testament in witness
whereof I do hereunto set my hand & seal
this twenty second day of July Eighteen hundred
and forty five
