2nd Item I desire and direct that all my just Debts
be paid with out delay by my Executors
Herein after appointed

3rd Item I Give bequeath and devise to my
Beloved wife Julia with whom I have lived
in the strictest quiet for many years lot of land
Containing one hundred Acres including the
houses beginning on a white Oak on Indian
Creek running a strale corner in Chiding
the field on the north west side of the spring
branch thence strale to Thomas line and
all the house & Kitchen subscriptions and
all the Farming Tools and all my horses
Cattle hogs and sheep and all other articles
on said Farm and hundred barrels corn
and all the Bacon on hand at my wife's
death the tract of Land that I left to her
I give to my youngest Son Singleton Hulse

4th Item I Give to my son Joke N. Hulse one
hundred Acres of Land adjoining Horn & others
Horseman as the Price Place.

I give to my son Francis
 Herbow one hundred acres of Land adjoining
 Open & Well and other lying on Indian Creek

6th I give to my son John Herbow
 one hundred acres of Land adjoining Sells
 Ways & other

7th I hereby constitute & appoint my
 beloved wife Sells Executrix and son John
 Herbow my Executor of this my last
 will and Testament this October the 23rd
 1848 Signed sealed in presence of us
