

George J. In the name of God Amen I Thomas & Barron of the
Jackson County & County of Wake of and being forth in Body but down of
Disposing Mind & Memory & Reasoning that it is appointed even for all Men
to Die Do Make this My last will & Testament in Manner & form following
(to wit)

Item 1st It is My will that My just Debt be Paid by My Executors hereinafter
named as soon after My Death as it can be conveniently done

Item 2^d I give & bequeath to My son William Barron one Hundred & Twenty
acres of land beginning on the south side of My land branching from
the town to the south & one further bed & beding & My son William Barron
shall pay to my two Daughters Annand & Elizabeth one
Hundred Dollars each within three years after My Death out of
his part of the land

Item 3^d I give unto my son Calven Barron the Remainder of My land and one
further bed & beding & he shall pay to my two Daughters Elizabeth & Ann
one Hundred Dollars each within three years from My Death
I also give to my Daughter Nancy Antons Barron one further bed
& beding & My love doing allth Barron & Calven Barron shall find my
Daughter Antons a decent support as long as she shall live
out of the land also it is My Will that all the balance of my property
shall be sold & divided amongst My Lawfull heirs

Item 4th I hereby nominate the Constable & appraiser My son William Barron to be
Executor to carry into effect this My last will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set My Hand & seal this 11th Day of
January 1853
