 Jackson County, I Thomas Millsaps of the State of Georgia afore-
 said, in sound mind & memory, do make & ordain this my last will
 & testament First I recommend my soul to God, who gave it &
 my body to be buried in a decent Christian burial, I hereby I appoint
 & constitute & ordain my son Hulse Millsaps & my son Ezekiel
 Millsaps as executors to this my last will & testament as to my
 worldly goods I give & bequeath in the following manner
 I give to my son Ezekiel the land & plantation whereon I now
 live & out hundred acres adjoining Jacob Millsaps on back
 creek & on lot in the 11th South District Houston Co 1897
 I further give to my son Ezekiel Millsaps my negro & white
 slaves, together with all my stock of horses, cattle & other live
 stock whatever together with all my household & kitchen
 furniture all the balance of my property is to be equally
 divided amongst all my children, In testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my seal this 3rd day
 of March 1835. Signed his
 sealed & acknowledged Thomas Millsaps
