White, Joseph White, Martin White, & I desire said portion
that will come to my daughter Mary Ann & Eliza White
to go to the Whites in my son James White as executor
for my daughter & that said property be controlled by said
executor for their benefit and use

them I and if the above named mentioned daughters (3) said
portion of the property should be equally divided between
my said daughters

them I it is my will that my three youngest children should
be sent to school and room & provisions equal to the
rest of my children & the expenses be paid of my said estate

them I it is my will that if there is any property on the plantation
more than the family needs that my executors sell it and
apply said amount to the use of the family

them I I hereby I hereby nominate my wife Leander & my sons
James E. White & Leander J. White executors of this my
last will & testament I witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal this 7 Day May 1854
