aforesaid being in a slow State of Health
and demand in mind & memory & knowing that it is expedient
for all men to see so make this my last will and
testament to wit

1st I appoint James Tolbert Executor and my wife Susanah
Beavers my Executrix

2^d I direct that the said Executors Dispose of or sell as much
of my Property as will pay my Debts say one or two of
my young Negroes

3^d I then give to my Wife Susanah all the Balance
of my Estate with the Exception of the sum of said
Property as will pay to each daughter as they arrive
at age what each of my Children has already received
that has married & left me which is partly understood
by my Executors

4th and when my youngest Child arrives at age all my
Property must be equally divided according to my Will
at that time the Part that the Laws of this State
allows to Widows under such circumstances that is
if she thinks proper to claim the same I desire the
Work or Income of said Property for Raising and
Supporting my Children

hand and affix my Seal in the Presence of this 15th Day of
August in the year of our Lord 1848
